

THEART OF JESUS why is the Sacred Heart important? St. John Paul II said, "The Sacred Heart has given us everything — redemption, salvation, sanctification." The Sacred Heart is the actual heart of Christ and also indicates His love for humanity. The Catechism of the

Catholic Church says, "The prayer of the Church venerates and honors the Heart of Jesus just as it invokes his most holy name. It adores the incarnate Word and his Heart which, out of love for men, he allowed to be pierced by our sins." (CCC 2669)



ANOINTING OF THE SICK

HOSPITALIZATION

Baptisms' are typically celebrated around weekend mass times.

INFANT BAPTISM

At least one Godparent should be an active-practicing catholic and provide documentation of their baptism & confirmation certificates. This sacrament, along with penance and Holy Communion, is available to anyone over the age of reason (nearing 7 yrs. old), Call 445.2497x5, 24/7/365 if you have an urgent need.

Even if you are not seriously ill, please call 445.2497x14 to let us know when you are hospitalized or confined to the home (pew envelopes are another way to let us know).

Receive anointing if you know you will be having serious tests or surgery or if you are growing weak with age, struggling with mental illness or addiction.

Please ask for the sacrament the weekend before a medical procedure. For children under seven, they should be baptized and the special blessing for sick children is administered. Viaticum is the sacrament of the dying and, if possible, Holy Communion in this form should be offered to them often.

Please contact a clergyman when someone has died so that he may assist the family in their grief. Remember, anyone can baptize in danger of death. Please email or call a priest personally at any time.

Provide patient's name, hospital, and exact room number.

FUNERALS

Services are scheduled by the funeral home. While you are meeting at the funeral home, have the funeral director call the pastor personally.
